LISTING FEE: The \$8.20 listing fee must be submitted for any dog without an individual CKC registration number or ERN number.

PLEASE NOTE: - Effective January 1, 2011 - Non-Member Participation Fee

- a) An annual non-member participation fee for awards and titles will be charged to a Canadian

non-member of CKC. The fee will match the ERN fee.

- b) In order to protect the awards/titles earned, the non-member will have a choice either to become a CKC member or to pay the non-member participation fee. Failure to comply within 30 days of notification will cause all awards and titles to be cancelled.
- c) These fees apply only to dogs wholly owned by non-CKC members and are not applicable to CKC members.

PAYMENT: Payment may be made by Cheque, Money Order or Cash at the time of entry. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.

N.S.F. CHEQUES: There will be a \$20.00 charge for N.S.F. cheques.

Excerpt from CKC Rules & Regulation for Hunt Test

Chap.18: Sec.7: "It shall be the duty and obligation of the event giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at a hunt test held under these regulations, is not subjected to indignities of any kind. The Hunt Test Committee Chair shall promptly report to the Canadian Kennel Club any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit on receipt of a report indicating this has occurred."
